### The cost of your eggs

On average, a hen eats around 200 grams of pellets a day, so 3 hens would eat 600 grams a day, meaning that a 20kg sack of pellets would last them one month. Over 52 weeks that works out about £4.00 a week in feed to keep 3 hens, in return for 1 ½ dozen eggs.

### A note about point of lay hens (POL)

Hens reach point of lay between the ages of 16 and 22 weeks. Some take far longer to start laying and hens are affected by many factors such as the weather, being moved etc. Remember, the old saying "***all the eggs will eventually come out***" ...

### **Sexed Female Chicks (*Sold out*)**
